

## Pilot with e-portfolio started at Aventus Smart Building and Smart Technology study programmes

One of the aspects of the Aventus educational vision is that every student should be able to follow his or her own learning route to achieve maximum growth. In addition, at Aventus we want to ensure that our students are ready for their future and are able to learn to solve the issues of tomorrow.

This requires adjustments in the way we organise and provide education. The new Aventus study programmes [Smart Building](#) en [Smart Technology](#) have chosen to let the students gain their knowledge, skills and competences through real-life assignments and/or projects. This means that a wide variety of learning routes will be followed. One of the challenges will be to keep track of what each student has learned and how to prove that. It was decided to use the [e-portfolio](#) tool of Zelfloopbaanmanagement.nl for this purpose.

On Wednesday 30 June 2021, Anneke Hemmen of Zelfloopbaanmanagement.nl organised two workshops about the e-portfolio tool including how to 'fill it'. This gave the 23 involved students a kickstart in setting up and filling their e-portfolios.
